We are a dedicated organization that walks alongside teen moms and their children through a time of transition, uncertainty, insecurity, and doubt. We walk together with these families to equip, educate, encourage, and empower with eyes fixed on a hopeful future.

Hope & Hygiene kits are one of the ways we support the mamas of Grace's Table. They include essential hygiene items mamas and babies require for healthy living. Often, low-income households struggle to provide diapers for their children, and only 4% of those who need diapers receive them from nationwide banks. When you donate hygiene items like diapers, you're keeping these kiddos clean, dry, and healthy.

We are seeking organizations and individuals who are willing to cover a month of hope and hygiene kits. This would include collecting specific items needed from our current checklist and delivering them to Grace's Table at the end of the month.

In the past, we've collected donations to create these kits, but COVID has created difficulty in receiving the correct supplies. These kits cost on average \$125 per family. Your involvement by collecting the necessary items for a month means you're allowing us to better walk alongside our families at Grace's Table!

BASIC STEPS TO RUN A HYGIENE DRIVE FOR GRACE'S TABLE

HYGIENE DRIVES ARE RUN IN THE FIRST THREE WEEKS OF THE MONTH

- 1. Let your network know the exact quantities and items needed
- 2. Collect the items from your network
- 3. Establish a drop-off date with your Grace's Table contact (listed above)
- 4. Drop off everything you've collected at Grace's Table on the last week of the month.

HYGIENE DRIVE SUGGESTED SCHEDULE

WEEK 1

- Prepare for Launch: Read through this packet and outline how you'd like to roll out this program.
- Collect specific branding and photography you'd like to use to spread the word. <u>Everything you'll need is here.</u>
- Kick-off the Event: Let your community know that you will be collecting specific hygiene items for the first three weeks of the month.
- Market the event kickoff with social media and emails
- Provide a space for people to sign-up
- Pick a designated area for people to bring in the specific items they signed up for.

WEEK 2

- Continue Collecting Items
- Marketing/Social Media Reminders
- Identify any items not chosen to be collected yet and utilize social media to fill those needs or make calls, or ask in person.



WEEK 3

Final Week to Collect Items

- Social Media Reminders
- Drop Off Coordination: Coordinate with Grace's Table Volunteer a date to drop off the items collected the following week.
- Spend some time going through the donated items to ensure all of the items needed were collected and/or if anything is missing.

WEEK 4

- Confirm drop-off date and time with Grace's Table
- Drop off all items to Grace's Table

Every month the families of Grace's Table receive a Hope & Hygiene Kit that is comprised of the following:

- Diapers sizes 4, 5, and 6 (we are not in need of smaller sizes)
- Pull-Ups for boys and for girls in sizes 2T-3T, 3T-4T, 4T-5T

Enfamil Gentlease (purple can)
Enfamil Infant Formula (yellow can)
Enfamil A.R. (pink can)
Enfamil ProSobee (green can)
